Knole is Set at the heart of a timeless deer park, Knole has fascinating links with kings, queens and nobility, as well as literary connections with the novelists Vita Sackville-West and Virginia Woolf.

Deer-park

Knole Park is one of the few deer-parks in England to have survived the past 500 years (there were 700 in the 16th century) and the only one in Kent. The park was first enclosed by a fence in 1456 by Thomas Bouchier to indulge a passion for hunting, which was popular among the nobility of the time.

This is a great opportunity to all members to meet up as a group outside of club nights and photograph some superb roaming deer.

It is quickly approaching rutting season so even more reason for this trip.

We will try to make arrangements for people without transport so all can enjoy this trip.
